THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS OF ENGLAND ORDINARY COUNCIL, 11TH DECEMBER, 1952

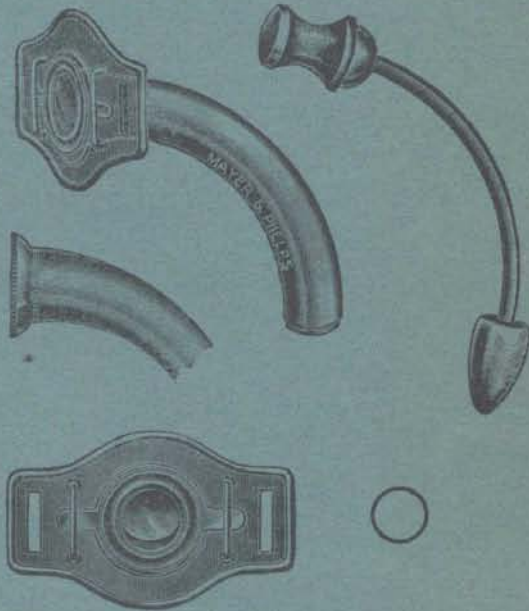
