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In this issue, (85–95) authors Gemma Taylor et al outline ways in which healthcare professionals can compassionately and respectfully raise the topic of smoking to encourage smoking cessation. They draw on evidence-based methods such as cognitive-behavioural therapy (CBT) and outline approaches that healthcare professionals can use to integrate these methods into routine care to help their patients stop smoking.
