In November 1974, a seminar was held at the Centre of African Studies, University of Edinburgh, in honour of Basil Davidson's sixtieth birthday. Distinguished scholars representing the disciplines with which he had been chiefly concerned contributed papers on the changes that have taken place in African Studies since the Second World War. They are now published as an affectionate tribute to a courageous and scholarly pioneer whose work and example have inspired a whole generation of Africanists. The collection has been edited for publication by Christopher Fyfe, Reader in African History at the Centre of African Studies, Edinburgh.

● LIBRARIES

University and college libraries, national libraries, national and regional library boards, major public libraries, libraries at polytechnics, colleges of technology and at other institutions of higher education; as well as British Council libraries, USIS libraries, and Centre Culturel Français libraries.

Plus over 400 important special libraries, with an index to subject areas covered.

Each entry will give full name and address, telephone number, name of chief librarian, names of acquisitions and serials librarian (for the larger libraries), size of collection, serial holdings, annual book budgets, details of special collections, and more.

● BOOKSELLERS

Over 300 major booksellers, educational and school book suppliers throughout the continent. Each entry will provide full name and address, telephone number, name of chief executive, number of employees, nature of stocks held, areas of specialization and, where applicable, details of export, book promotion, and subscription services.

● PERIODICALS & MAGAZINES

Carefully selected listings of the most important magazines, journals and periodicals, with an emphasis on scholarly and academic publications, literary and cultural magazines, and journals in the areas of commerce, finance and industry. Each entry will include full name and address, name of editor, a brief outline of scope and contents, frequency, subscription rates, circulation, details whether carrying book reviews, and advertising rates and data. An index to subjects covered by the various magazines and periodicals will also be provided.

● PUBLISHERS

Some 200 active publishers—private, state-sponsored, scholarly—each entry giving full name and address, telephone number, telex/cable address and, for the majority of entries, information will also include names of senior management staff, number of employees, nature of list, areas of specialization, number of books in print, foreign publishers represented, and agents overseas where applicable.

● INSTITUTIONS/SOCIETIES

Research institutions, learned societies, and professional associations with publishing programmes, each entry listing full name and address, telephone number, name of director and/or publications officer in charge, areas of specialization, journals and special series published.

● BOOK INDUSTRY & LITERARY ASSOCIATIONS

Details of publishers' associations, booksellers' associations, library associations, writers' groups, and literary societies, giving names of secretaries and information on membership, activities, etc.

● NEWSPAPERS

Details on all of Africa's most influential newspapers. Information provided will include full name and address, telephone number, cable/telex address, name of editor-in-chief, name of book review/literary editor (where applicable), size and column width, frequency, subscription rates, plus details of circulation and basic advertising rates and data.

● OTHER FEATURES

These will include information about book clubs, literary prizes and awards, book fairs, as well as a bibliography of books, reports, and articles on publishing and book development in Africa.
