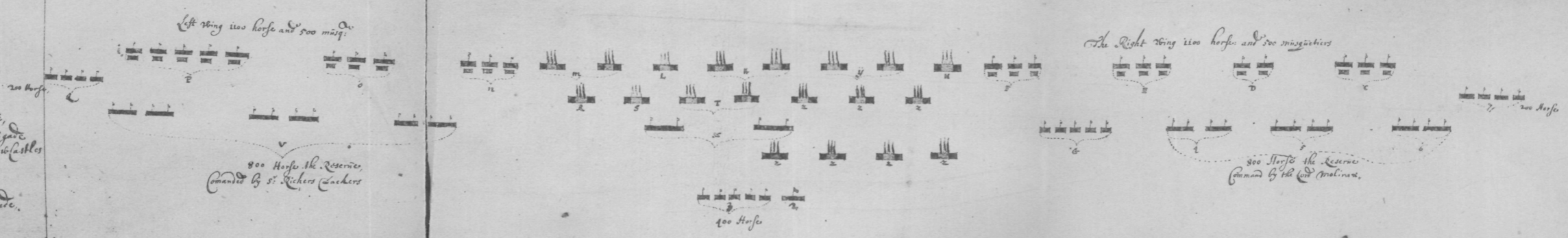


The front of the parliament and the Scots Army consisting about 27000 Men
