in Ecclesiastical History has fallen vacant in the Faculty of Theology. The post will involve teaching Dutch ecclesiastical history, ecclesiastical law and general ecclesiastical history from 1650.

Should it appear desirable, the teaching commitments within the Department of Ecclesiastical History might be altered in such a way that the professor to be appointed would be entrusted with teaching general ecclesiastical history with especial reference to the period since 1650.

The appointee will undertake teaching and research; he/she must also be prepared to carry out administrative tasks.

Applicants are informed that a special relationship exists between the Faculty and the Reformed Churches in the Netherlands with regard to the training of their pastors.

Agreement with the following statement of aim is a condition for appointment: "The Free University consciously aims directing all of its work, in obedience to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, toward the service of God and his world".
