Distinction awards

A brief guide

Two subjects which can be relied upon to arouse strong affect in consultants are control of hospital beds and allocation of distinction awards. The processes attending the latter are regarded by some as arcane, mysterious and anything but sublime. This note is intended to provide a little background and to outline the machinery which determines who, each year will receive an award. In particular it will underline the role of the College in this operation.

Criteria for awards

Broadly speaking there must be evidence of something over and above the ordinary expectations of consultant work. There are two principal dimensions:

1. *Meritorious service* Clinical excellence is the hallmark here, e.g. the consultant who is regularly sought out for a further opinion; maintenance of a high standard despite

adverse facilities or poor local backing; development of an excellent service; successful building-up of a new department.

Involvement in teaching at under- or postgraduate level; participation in clinical meetings; the making of original observations or other research contributions; good work in the field of medical administration.

2. *Distinction* Consultants who are evident leaders in a clinical or scientific field or who are generally accepted as leaders of the profession in their Region or in the country as a whole.

Doctors with honorary consultant contracts are eligible and if they hold a minimum of six sessions will receive the full value of the award.
