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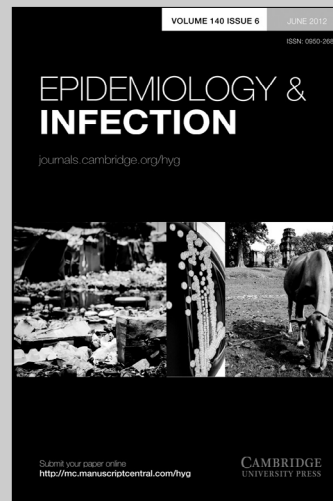

Nationally recognized artist Mark E. Mehaffey is a signature member of numerous artist societies in the United States. Mehaffey has won major awards in juried exhibitions across the US, including the Beverly Green Memorial Purchase Award from the National Watercolor Society; The Silver Medal of Honor (2008 and 2013) and The Arches Paper Company Award from the American Watercolor Society; the M. Grumbacher Gold Medal from Allied Artists of America; the Skyledge Award from the National Transparent Watercolor Society of America; and the Ruth Rosenau Silver Medallion from the Adirondacks National exhibition of American watercolors. In 2010, Mark was invited to participate and was given an award in the Shanghai Zhujiyajiao Biennial in Shanghai China.

Mehaffey's work has appeared in many publications, and his paintings are included in many corporate, public, and private collections globally. He is a popular juror and gives workshops and lectures around the United States. Mark's watercolor book, "Creative Watercolor Workshop," was released in 2005 and re-released in 2012. Creative Catalyst and North Light Publications have produced nine instructional videos featuring Mark's work. Mark is a retired public school art instructor who believes our art future is with the young and is dedicated to building that vision.
