**'Kant and German Idealism' at the University of Sheffield**

The Department of Philosophy at Sheffield is offering a new one-year programme on 'Kant and German Idealism', which can be taken either as an MA degree, or as a research-training year leading to a place as a PhD student. Courses on offer within the programme (of which students choose four) are as follows: 'Kant'; 'Hegel and his Critics', 'Kant and German Idealism Research Seminar'; 'Epistemology'; 'Metaphysics'; 'Phenomenology'. The Department can also offer scholarships on a competitive basis, which cover maintenance and full fees (for Home and EC students).
