A. SZAKATS, "The Influence of Commonwealth Law Principles on the Uniform Law on the International Sale of Goods" (1966) I.C.L.Q. (July) 749-779.

IN the July issue of I.C.L.Q. on p. 749, note 6, and on p. 779, reference was made to the Donaldson Committee and it was quoted that in their view "there was no demand or need for any changes in the law as contained in the Sale of Goods Act." Publication No. 9 (1964), pp. 38-42, was referred to. In fact no such comment was made by the Committee. The author expresses his regret for the error.
