Other important papers include *The Greek Church under the Ottoman Turks* by Sir Steven Runciman; *The Papacy as an Institution of Government in the Middle Ages* by Dr Walter Ullmann; *The Unit of Pastoral Care in the Early Church* by Professor S. L. Greenslade; *Church and State, 1558-1612: The Task of the Cecils* by Professor Joel Hurstfield; *Wyclif's Theory of Dominion and Grace* by Michael Wilks; and *Puritanism: The Problem of Definition* by Basil Hall. The Seventeen 'Communications' cover many subjects, from the Great Persecution to Dr Arnold.
