APSA's Annual Meeting returns to Washington, DC, as the city celebrates its 200th year as the nation's capital! Led by Program Co-Chairs Ira Katznelson and Helen Milner, both of Columbia University, the 96th meeting will feature over 700 panel sessions, beginning on August 30 and continuing through mid-day on September 3, 2000. 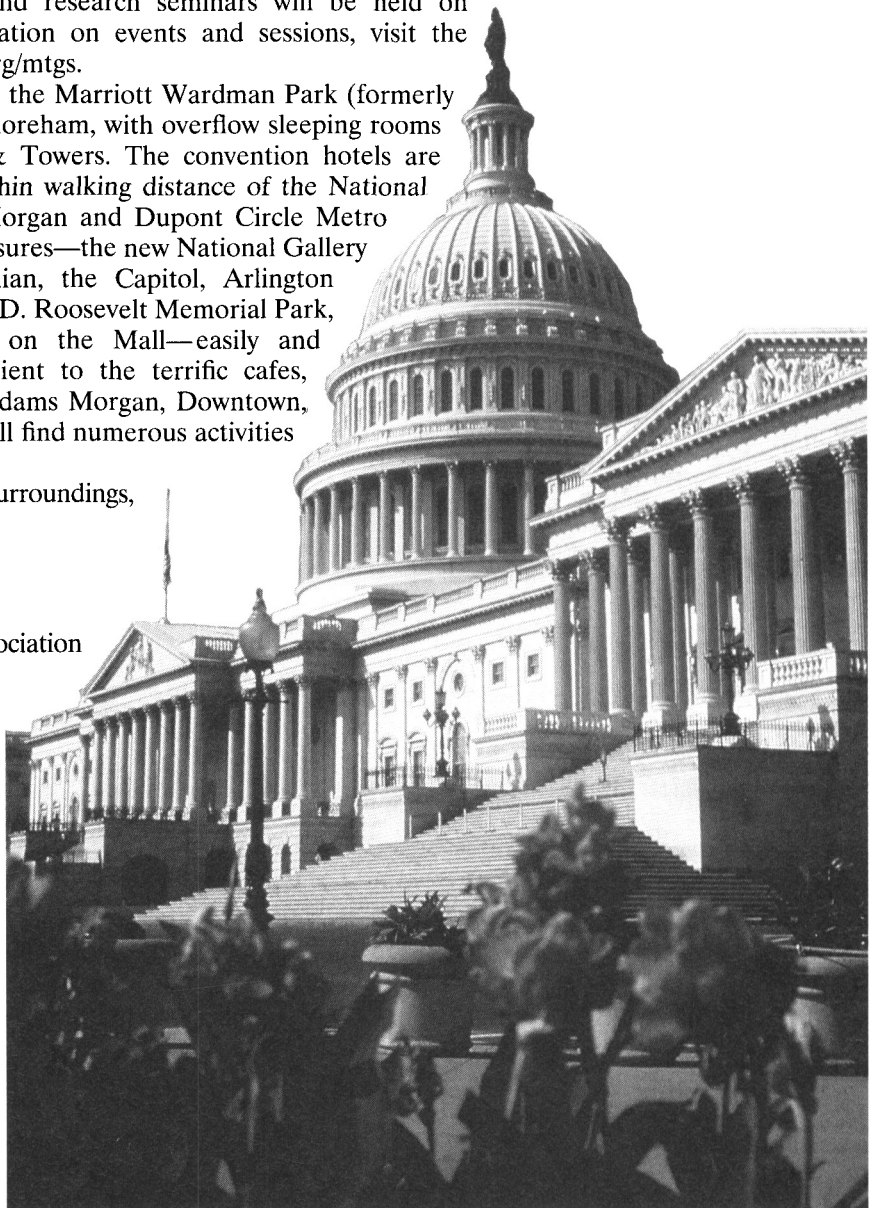
