ADVANCED COURSE IN PAEDIATRIC ASPECTS OF OTOLARYNGOLOGY

A one-week course in the paediatric aspects of otolaryngology will be held at the Institute of Child Health, from 5 to 9 November 1973, in association with the Institute of Laryngology and Otology.
