

EDITORIAL

From January next (1989) it is proposed, for the first time, to have two levels of subscription to The Journal—one for consultants, hospital, libraries, etc., as at present, but also a reduced level for those 'in-training' (Registrars/Senior Registrars/Residents/Interns). To qualify, for the latter, the applicant must give his or her private address to which the Journal will be mailed and provide a statement from his/her Consultant/Head of Department that they are a genuine trainee (Associate Professors will not be eligible). It is hoped that this will help those in their earlier years to have their own copy both for reading at the time and for future reference. The reduced rate will be £35/\$90 (including postage); the full rate will be £60/\$150.
