The Biography of Dr. Leonard Colebrook, FRS

W. C. NOBLE

Leonard Colebrook was trained and directed by Sir Almroth Wright in the company of Alexander Fleming and V. Zachary Cope. That he never received public honour was due to his shy, retiring nature, for his work was understood and appreciated by his many colleagues. He was successful in reducing infection in both childbed (puerperal) fever and in burns by a meticulous attention to detail and a willingness to adopt and modify new ideas, though the most spectacular success was reserved for his introduction of the first truly effective antimicrobial drugs, the Sulphonamides. Skin transplantation received a systemic study and a scientific basis as a result of his attempts to prevent infection and the crippling sequelae of burns and scalds.

In his retirement he was responsible for a Parliamentary Bill which reduced the toll of burns and scalds by legislating for a safer domestic environment. Finally he took up the cause of Euthanasia in a genuine last attempt to reduce human misery. Colebrook had fully intended to become a medical missionary and it is for his fighting missionary spirit that he should be remembered.
