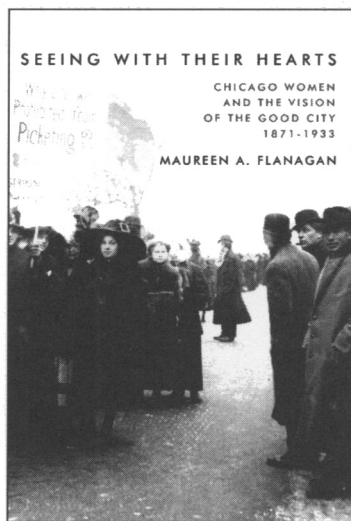

## Seeing with Their Hearts

Chicago Women and the Vision of the Good City, 1871–1933

At the turn of the last century, as industrialists and workers made Chicago the hard-working City of Big Shoulders celebrated by Carl Sandburg, Chicago women articulated an alternative City of Homes in which the welfare of residents would be the municipal government's principal purpose. *Seeing with Their Hearts* traces the formation of this vision from the relief efforts following the Chicago fire of 1871 through the many political battles of the Gilded Age and Progressive Era. In the process, it presses a new understanding of the roles of women in public life and writes a new history of urban America.
