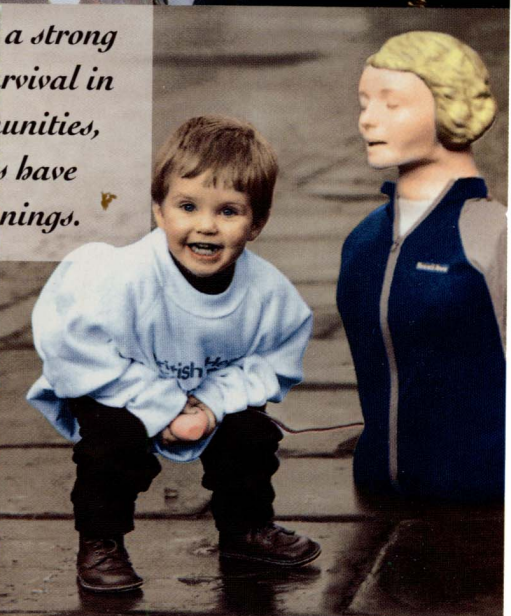
Submerged in a pond for 30 minutes, the life of 2 year-old Hal was saved by his father who had just learned CPR.

Because of the dedication, training and skills of emergency medical services and a strong Chain of Survival in their communities, these lives have new beginnings.*

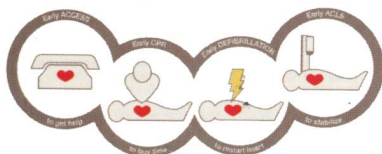
15 year-old heart attack victim T. J. Christensen was given the gift of life by the training and fast response of his teachers and the Sheboygan Fire/Rescue squad.
