**Date:** 23 - 26 July 1997

The conference is sponsored by the International College of Nutrition and the University of Alberta, and will be a satellite conference of the 16th International Congress of Nutrition to be held in Montreal, Canada, 27 July to 1 August 1997.

*Theme of Conference:* In recent years the possible role of anti-oxidant substances present in fruit and vegetables has received much attention. There is now considerable evidence that they may play a protective role against various diseases, especially cancer and heart disease. However, a great deal of work still needs to be done to identify the anti-oxidants present in foods, and to determine which substances are protective against different diseases.

The conference will be divided into the following major parts:

1. Anti-oxidant substances present in foods
2. Anti-oxidants and cancer
3. Anti-oxidants and heart disease
4. Anti-oxidants and other health effects (eg. immune system)

The program will include both oral and poster presentations.
