OF ROBERT MOFFAT, VOL ONE: 1829-1854

THE OPPENHEIMER SERIES will consist of hitherto unprinted records of the early history of Southern Rhodesia, selected from the Historical MSS. division of the Government Archives, Salisbury. It will contain approximately a dozen volumes, numbered serially and uniformly bound and priced, which will appear at intervals of 4 to 6 months.

The first publication in it, *The Matabele Journals of Robert Moffat, vol. 1*, is mostly comprised of letters written by the missionary during his five visits to the native chieftain, Moselekatse, from 1829 to 1854.
