The Centre for Information on Language Teaching, established in 1966, is an independent foundation supported by grants from the Department of Education and Science, the Scottish Education Department, and the Ministry of Education, Northern Ireland. It coordinates and provides information about all aspects of modern languages (including English as a second language) and their teaching in Great Britain. Further information can be obtained from:

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ETIC and CILT, which occupy adjacent accommodation, maintain jointly the Language-Teaching Library (about 20,000 volumes), where files of journals covered by *Language-Teaching Abstracts* may be consulted. The library also includes an audio-visual section with facilities for hearing and viewing teaching materials; a register of relevant current research is available for reference.

In addition to joint publications such as *Language-Teaching Abstracts*, and *A Language-Teaching Bibliography* each centre issues publications from time to time in its own name.
