MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

"Computer Science and Statistics: Fifth Annual Symposium on the Interface"
Oklahoma State University, November 1 and 2, 1971

A two-day meeting to be held at Stillwater, Oklahoma is open to all those who are interested in the relationships between computer science and statistics. The keynote speaker will be H. O. Hartley of Texas A&M University. Concurrent workshops will be conducted in five areas:

Time Series and Stochastic Processes: Emanuel Parzen, State University of New York, Buffalo, Chairman

Decision Sciences: Dennis Grawoig, Georgia State University, Atlanta, Chairman

Compumetrics: Robert Gordon, University of California, Irvine, Chairman

Computer Science and Statistics in Higher Education: J. L. Folks, Oklahoma State University and Ron Mohler, University of Oklahoma, Cochairmen

Computer Science and Statistics in the Extractive Industries

Persons having papers in any of these five areas (up to about eight pages) are invited to submit them to the conference chairman, Dr. Mitchell O. Locks, Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, Oklahoma 74074, to be considered for presentation and for possible incorporation into the proceedings. A complete paper is preferable to an abstract. Likewise, anyone who wishes to receive the conference brochure when it is issued may notify the chairman.

This national conference is being held under the cosponsorship of Oklahoma State University, The University of Oklahoma, North Texas State University, the University of Tulsa, and certain industrial firms in the midcontinent region. The four previous meetings were all held in southern California, under the sponsorship of the Southern California Chapter of the American Statistical Association, the Los Angeles chapter of the Association for Computing Machinery, the Statistical Program Evaluation Committee, and were hosted by UCLA and the University of California, Irvine. The sixth (1972) meeting in this series will be held at Berkeley.
