RUSSELL CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS, Oct. 12-14, 1972

Plans are underway at McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario for the celebration of the one-hundredth anniversary of Bertrand Russell's birth. Visiting speakers include: Sir A. J. Ayer, Mr. I. F. Stone, Mr. Christopher Farley of the Russell Peace Foundation, Professor S. P. Rosenbaum, Professor N. Rescher. The programme will also include films, tapes, and play entitled "The Chair of Indecency" dealing with the opposition to Russell's appointment to CCNY in 1940.
