

RECENT DEATHS

FRANCISCO ANTONIO ENCINA, a Chilean historian of note, died in Santiago in September, 1965. He was the author of a famous *Historia de Chile desde la prehistoria hasta 1891* (1940-1952) in 20 volumes, of which Leopoldo Castedo made a very successful (six editions since 1954) *Resumen*. Among Encina's earlier works is his pioneering essay in socio-economics, *Nuestra inferioridad económica* (1912), still valuable after the passage of years. In 1961-1962 he published the last two volumes of a series of four on *Bolívar y la independencia de la América Española*. (L. G. C.)
