The 1992 International Congress of the International Society for Utilitarian Studies was held at the University of Western Ontario on 3–5 April 1992. Papers were read by: James Moore (Concordia), R. The conference was most expertly organized by Professor Douglas Long to whom all participants are greatly indebted and was supported by the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada and the University of Western Ontario.

At the ISUS business meeting, Professor Long retired as Chairman and Professor J. H. Burns, as President. Unanimously elected to succeed them were Professor Yoshio Nagai as Chairman and Professor J. M. Robson as President. The next major conference will be held in Tokyo at Chuo University on 27–29 August 1994.
