Since September 1988, Commission 38 assisted the travel of 5, 12 and 8 astronomers in 1988, 1989 and 1990 respectively, disbursing a total of 56,000 Sw.F. The bulk of these grants was to assist astronomers from the developing world spend a period of three months or longer at a host institution to further their astronomical research.
